
## Venue

We have the rooms on hold for this event and have been able to negotiate a lower rate for bookings associated to the GPC. However, for this rate the booking does need to be done over the telephone - informing them the booking is for GPC Championships. All rooms will be held until 2 months prior to the event, with any unbooked rooms being released to general public. Once you have booked you do not need to pay for this until 4 days prior to arrival.

Booking online or through a third party website will give you a higher rate and will **not** include B&B.



### **Rates are as follows:**

- Single room occupancy - £92.00 ( per night)
- Double /Twin room - £102.00 ( per night)

*This rate includes breakfast and access to the Health & Wellbeing centre (Gym, heated pool, Jacuzzi, Steam room & Sauna)*

## Lifting Room

The room hosting the European Championships will be split into two parts.

The Main area will be the competition area with the warm up area to the side (within same room). There is multiple projectors and TV's within this room which we will display the flight information, this will be able to be viewed from the platform, desk and within the warm up area.

Close by but separate to the competition room we have a weigh in room where you can privately weigh in and have equipment checked.

## Food & Drink

The 'BBar & Grill' is the hotel's main restaurant and is situated just outside the lifting room. You can find the menu here:

Above this, we have discussed with the events manager about further food options, given the nature of this even.

There will be an agreed set menu added within the restaurant. At certain times throughout the day there will be hot food buffet options (due to Health & Safety regulations hot food cannot sit out all day so this will be twice a day for a set time).

In the welcome area you will be able to purchase drinks, Teas and coffees, pre made sandwiches and snacks etc.

## Getting to the Venue

### Glasgow Airport

- Driving - It is a 16 minute drive from Glasgow Airport to the venue. As you arrive into Glasgow there is a taxi rank outside and car hire options available within the terminal.
- Bus - There is an hourly bus by 'McGill's' which is number 757 which runs from Glasgow Airport to Dumbarton road. From there the venue is a 15 minute walk. The cost for this is around £5.00 and the bus journey takes 40 minutes.
- Train - Dalmuir Station is the closest train station to the venue. ( 15 minute walk from station to venue)

There is no direct train from Glasgow airport to Dalmuir. However, you can get the 500 Airport Express bus which will take you to Blythswood Street in the heart of Glasgow city centre (13 minutes). From there, you can get a train from Glasgow Central to Dalmuir (26 minutes).


### Edinburgh Airport

- Driving - Approx. one hour drive.
- Bus - Buses run from Edinburgh airport to Glasgow city centre. Where you can then get a bus or train from there to Dalmuir.
- Train/Tram - There is a Tram from Edinburgh airport that takes you to Edinburgh Park train station ( 13 minutes) where you can get a train from there to Dalmuir (1hr 36 minutes) This is a 'ScotRail' train. Please see their website for train times and prices. You can pay on the train or at the station.

Coaches from England - MegaBus to coaches all round the country. For example from Birmingham to Glasgow is around 7/8 hours and approx. £15.00.

## The Area



As you can see from above, all the essentials are close by and within walking distance to the main street where there are local convenience stores, take aways, Polish deli, pubs and public transport access.

Braehead shopping centre which has loads of shops and places to eat is a 20 minute drive away from the venue.

A smaller, closer shopping centre is Clydebank shopping centre. You can see this on the above map to the right hand side with an ASDA and ALDI close by. This is within a 6 minute drive from the venue.

Easy access from Dalmuir station to the city centre if you wish to spend some time there.
